VSPOA BY-LAW UPDATES—PROPOSED CHANGES

A seven member sub-committee of VSPOA officers & board members continue working with the intent of bringing you, the residents, an updated set of VSPOA By-Laws on which to vote during the General Membership Meeting in November, 2010. The current set of by-laws were last amended in 1995. Some of the by -laws are outdated and are no longer applicable, while others were recommended for review. The subcommittee will present their proposal for board approval during the September 2010 board meeting. The approved language will be voted on by all residents in attendance at the November 2010. N. RIVER ROAD BIKE PATH UPDATE

The VS board held an informational meeting in May to give our residents an update on the Harrison Township proposed bike path (slated to run along N. River Road) and to give Venice Shores residents a chance to voice their concerns. When all the dust settled, it was decided that the actual bike path will cross at Bridgeview and will parallel the shoulder on the north side of N. River Road, extending east up to MacRays' entrance. The path will not continue to Clairpointe, as was originally planned. A sidewalk that would run from MacRays to Bayhaven, on Township owned property, is still being considered.

Designed for the VS resident, you will be able to access the latest information, including board meeting agendas & minutes, plus names & pictures of VSPOA board members. able. Fun & informational buttons will access features such as VS photos, Newsletters, Events (past & upcoming), Deed Restrictions, By-Laws, & Enforcement Procedures. You'll be able to find your property using Google Earth, and access other websites of local & relevant interest right from the VS site. Map links, Army Core of Engineers, local government, and Lake St. Clair news are just a few. Local weather will also be displayed when the site is opened, so you don't have to search to see if it's a good day to play hooky and go fishing. The site will also be useful to realtors. They can direct perspective buyers to the site to give them a preview of our great community. It will feature a pictorial tour of Venice Shores, including street and canal views, entrance views, and a view of MacRay's exit to the lake. And for Venice Shores property owners only, you will be able to **privately and securely** join the VS email mailing list. Adding your email address to this list will allow VS to communicate with you quickly about relevant topics, and to pass along informational flyers. Past topics have included information and net layouts in Lake St. Clair for invasive fish species, notification of special informational meetings, and closures of local roads for special events that impact our community. This list will NEVER be sold, shared, or otherwise accessed except to communicate genuine information. It will NEVER be used to pass jokes, and will not be available to VS residents on-line. It is used only for Venice Shores business and will be controlled by a Venice Shores officer. So look for the new website in late July! We think you'll find it fun and informative!

Please also remember that boats, sea-doos and other recreational or maintenance items may not protrude into canal right-of-ways per VSPOA Deed Restrictions, Section 9. Violations are subject to penalties set forth in Policy #VSPOA-0001, which is strictly enforced by the VSPOA Board of Directors.
