## POND OR LAKE TREATMENT NOTICE

Property owners in this area are planning to have the waterbody treated for nuisance aquatic weeds, algae or floating/emergent vegetation. This notice is required by the MDEQ (Michigan Department of Environmental Quality) prior to the first treatment of each calendar year if your property falls in or within 100' of the area of impact.

Treatments typically begin in late April and may continue until early October depending on the program. The frequency of these treatments can range from every 2 to 4 weeks. Due to changing weather conditions, exact dates cannot be established at this time. Contact our office with the notice number at the top of the page for more information on treatment dates and treatment area.

Please look for large yellow or bright colored signs (See back for example) that will be posted every 100ft along the treatment area and up to 100' away. These signs will be posted the day of treatment and have the date and time of treatment, chemicals used and the appropriate restrictions for swimming, irrigation of your lawn and/or crops, drinking (main source of drinking water), and fish consumption. All signs must be left in place until all restrictions expire. If there are no restrictions in place then the signs can be discarded 24 hours after treatment. A sample of the treatment notification sign is on the back of this letter which also shows water use restrictions.

We may use one or more of each product listed on the back of this page depending on the target pest. Please watch for the notification signs in your yard. The products used for that particular treatment will be marked with a check next to the product on the posting sign. We use new posting signs for each treatment.
